

ORDINANCE NO. 1196

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE 1102 AND SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE 1006, RELATING TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF CAWKER CITY, CONCERNING MEETING FEES RENDERED TO MEMBERS OF THE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CAWKER CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance 1102 and Section 2 of Ordinance 1006 of the City of Cawker City is hereby amended to read as follows:


Section 2. The members of the Cawker City Fire Department shall be volunteers. They shall meet at least once a month for practice and drills. The secretary of the Fire Department shall keep a record of the members' attendance to monthly meetings and fire call runs for the department and the Chief. Any member who fails to attend six consecutive meetings shall automatically be expelled from the fire department.

For services rendered to the department, the following fees shall be paid: the Chief shall be paid the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per calendar year; the Assistant Chief shall be paid the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per calendar year; the Secretary shall be paid the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per calendar year; the Treasurer shall be paid the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per calendar year; and the Training Coordinator shall be paid the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per calendar year.

All members of the department shall receive the sum of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per meeting for attending monthly meetings and/or drills and fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for attendance at each fire call.

Section 2: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
