

ORDINANCE NO. 1126

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES NUMBERED 1055 AND 1058 WHICH REGULATES SEMI-TRACTOR AND/OR SEMI-TRAILER PARKING UPON THE HIGHWAYS OF THE CITY OF CAWKER CITY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CAWKER CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1: Except as provided for in Section 93 of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities as adopted by the City of Cawker City, and Section 14-202, Article 2, Chapter XIV, as amended, of the Code of the City of Cawker City, Kansas, it shall be unlawful for any person to park a semi-tractor and/or semi-trailer with a registered gross weight of more than 32,000 pounds, on any street in a residential district for longer than seventy-two (72) hours.


Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to disconnect from a tractor designated to pull a semi-trailer, so that any part of such semi-trailer is supported by dollies or support not bearing on a tractor designated to **pull** such semi-trailer unless the owner or person in his possession complies with the remaining provisions of this Section. Any person leaving a semi-trailer disconnected from a tractor shall cause to be placed between dollies and support for trailers and pavement, a wooden plank of such thickness and width that no portion of a semi-trailer other than wheels with pneumatic tires come in contact with the pavement. Such plank shall be 36" in length and of such thickness that it does not break, crush or crumble and so that the weight will be distributed over the entire length of the plank. Provided, however, that any semi-trailer shall not remain on any street for a period of longer than seventy-two (72) hours.

Section 3: It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance and any person who has been convicted of violating this ordinance shall be subject to a fine by the Court not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), as set forth in Section 201(c) of the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities, adopted by the City of Cawker City, Kansas.


Section 4: Ordinances numbered 1055 and 1058 are hereby repealed.
