CITY ATTORNEY REPORT: C. Martin went over the Water Rate Ordinance 1205 as there was a correction in rates listed when it was originally published. C. Eberle made the motion to approve the correction of the rates, J. Moyer seconded, motion carried 4 AYES- C. Suter abstained.

CITY EMPLOYEES REPORT:

J. Biddle: Went over the Build Back Kansas Matching state grant funds agreement that assist with the power pole replacement grant. B. Schlaefli made the motion to approve the agreement, J. Moyer seconded, motion carried 4 AYES- C. Suter abstained.

J. Biddle asked about visiting dogs, as there was an out of state visitor inquiring about the current ordinance and if there was anything about the number of visiting dogs allowed. This discussion was tabled for a future meeting.

C. Gullion: Discussed sewer lining/camera lng which did not do last year due to other projects. The cost would be \$30,000 and could not go over that amount. B. Schlaefli motion to approve what we can complete with the cap of \$30,000, J. Moyer seconded, motion carried 4 AYES – C. Suter abstained.

Biddle also gave update on the Park Renovations and stated that the grant has been applied for and should know if awarded by the 24th of February.
