ORDINANCE NO. 1139

AN ORDINANCE MAKING CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE 1, GENERAL PROVISIONS, CHAPTER IX OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CAWKER CITY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CAWKER CITY, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1:</u> The following section of Article 1, Chapter IX of the Cawker City Code is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 9.112. COURT COSTS.

- (a) In all cases filed in the municipal court of the city where there is a finding of guilty, or a plea of guilty, a plea of no contest, forfeiture of a bond, or a diversion, there shall be assessed a cost in the amount of \$100 for the administration of justice in the municipal court of the city and for the municipal judge training fund established in K.S.A. 12-4116, regarding the assessment of fees for the training, testing and continuing education of municipal judges. Also included in said court costs is a judicial branch education fee of \$1, a \$1 fee to the local law enforcement training reimbursement fund, a \$11.50 fee to the law enforcement training center fund annual operating expenses and critical capital outlay needs, a \$2.50 fee for annual operating expenses of the Kansas Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training (KSCPOST), a \$2 fee to the juvenile detention facilities fund, a \$0.50 fee to the Protection from Abuse Fund, a \$0.50 fee to the Crime Victims Assistance Fund, and a \$1 fee to the trauma fund of the Kansas Department of Health and Environment.
- (b) For the purpose of the municipal judge training fund, parking violations shall not be considered as cases.
- (c) In addition thereto, the municipal judge of the city is authorized and empowered to assess witness fees and mileage, permitted and allowed pursuant to K.S.A. 12-4411.
- Section 2: All ordinances and resolutions conflicting with this amendment are hereby repealed.
- <u>Section 3:</u> This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and one publication in the official city newspaper.
