

ORDINANCE NO. 1150

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XV, UTILITIES, ARTICLE 5, SOLID WASTE, OF THE CITY OF CAWKER CITY, KANSAS; LIMITING ITEMS THAT MAY BE BURNED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CAWKER CITY, KANSAS:

Section 1: The following section of Article 5, Chapter XV of the Cawker City Code is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 15-526. CITY TREE BURN SITE. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit anything other than tree branches or grass clippings and leaves at the city tree burn site of the city located in the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section 20, Township 6, Range 10 West of the 6th P.M., Mitchell County, Kansas.

(b) All such material shall pass through a gate as provided at a public entrance which will be closed at all times except as prescribed by the city council and posted at such place of entry and will be in charge of a caretaker furnished by the city, who will have supervision of the yard dumping, burning, or other disposal of tree branches or grass clippings and leaves.

(c) The city tree burn site shall be open from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays throughout the year. Any change of the hours of operation shall be made by motion duly passed and recorded in the minutes of the governing body of the city, published in the official city paper and posted at the gate of the city tree burn site.

(d) All tree branches dumped at the city tree burn site shall be trimmed and cut into lengths of eight feet or less and shall be piled separately from grass clippings and leaves.

(e) There shall be no burning of trash, rubbish, refuse, or other waste material at the city tree burn site.


(f) Use of the city tree burn site of the city for all purposes as herein provided shall be confined to residents, property owners and firms, located within the boundaries of the city and may extend to residents of Cawker City Township upon annual agreement between the township board and the governing body of the city.

Section 2: All ordinances and resolutions conflicting with this amendment are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and one publication in the official city newspaper.
